



# Revenue Update April 29, 2021

- Financials Remain very strong
- Total Sales tax collections April 1, 2018 through February , 2021 are \$177,604,967.19
- Interest to date \$1,700,616.29
- Total to date \$179,398,764.72, compared to projected revenue of \$183,082,807.69— which did not include interest
- Variance of \$3,684,042.97, or 2.01%
- Value of BOC authorized SPLOST funds and pending projects, such as the next round of resurfacing projects, is \$157,481,800; is 41% of the referendum value and 88% of the revenue to date





#### **Resurfacing Program**

- Resurfacing Budget \$151,250,000
- 150 miles let to contract, 117 completed
- Current average cost per mile is just under \$500,000
- Pending bids for next 50 miles will be an indicator if asphalt and labor costs are trending upward, at current costs, we expect to complete original needs list
- Average annual LMIG award is \$4M, additional \$16M expected over life of the program
- Progress is updated weekly and accessible thru SPLOST link on County's web site



### Major First Quarter Activities

- Fire Station 7 Construction Active
- Fire Academy Improvements on schedule
- Fire Station Roof Replacements started
- Property research underway for next five new fire stations
- Bids received for Tennis and multi use court improvements
- Glen Emerald Park Improvements underway
- Gresham Park Synthetic Turf installation ongoing
- Right of Way work active for Old Castle Trail Project
- Construction continues on federal aid sidewalk and trail projects: South River, Rockbridge Rd., Henderson Rd., Flat Shoals Rd. and Salem Rd.
- Design underway for North Decatur Corridor from Lullwater to E. Rock Springs
- Cedar Grove Bridge design underway



## Second and Third Quarter Activities

- Library Restroom Renovation Design Scheduled to be Completed
- Updated Courthouse Parking Deck Evaluation to be Completed
- Present Evidence Storage Alternatives to Facilities and Public Safety; current location in Bobby Burgess Building has structural issues
- Present Courthouse Facility Needs Assessment
- Close out Senior and Health Center Project Categories
- Continue Park Projects, including, but not limited to play grounds, shelters and rec centers
- Ramp up Transportation Project Design Activities
