



DEKALB SPLOST FUNDS NEW ROOFING AT COMMUNITY FINE ARTS CENTER

DeKalb County, Ga – Repair of Capital Outlay Projects – Parks and Recreation is a portion of the DeKalb SPLOST (one-cent Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax) budget that is allocated for renovations, upgrades, and modernization of equipment to make them more accessible and useable for DeKalb County residents. Total funding for these projects is \$37 million.

The SPLOST team recently installed new roofing to help maintain the existing facility at Callanwolde Fine Arts Center, which is supported in part by DeKalb County Parks, Recreation & Cultural Affairs. Located on a historic 12-acre estate, this popular fine arts center has a significant presence in the community and offers a variety of art classes, live performances, gallery exhibitions, artist markets, tours and more.
