



Proposed Substantial Amendment to the 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan, including the 2019 Annual Action Plan

DeKalb County is proposing to amend to the 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan, including the 2019 Annual Action Plan to include funding for In-Rem boarding and two full-time Code Enforcement officers. The Community Development Department seeks to utilize \$335,000 in CDBG and/or Program Income from 2019 and prior years' program income to allocate \$135,000 to fund two (2) full-time positions for the Code Enforcement Division that will function as Code Enforcement officers. In addition, allocate \$200,000 dollars to fund the In-Rem boarding/securing of blighted structures.

The funding will address the need for supplemental inspections for code violations and enforcement of code in deteriorating or deteriorated areas. In addition, the Department will fund the cost of boarding/securing blighted structures that constitutes a hazard to the health or safety to the community.
